E. 10000 (Special) (480 ci max) (18 mph Pace)
F. 9500 Hot Farm (Pickett Pullers)

G. 10500 (Farm) (8 mph Pace)
H. 12500 (Farm) (8 mph Pace)
(Both- Max Tire 20.8.42 or 24.5.32)
J. 11500 (No Pace)
K. 14500 (Farm) (8 mph Pace)
L. 16500 (Farm) (8 mph Pace)

(100 lb over weight allowed in all classes)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Farm tractors only, as is from factory.
2. No duals, chains, lugs, or four wheel drives allowed.
3. Driver pulls at his own risk.
4. Driver must be 16 years of age. Those under 18 must have written permission.
5. Entry fee will be paid at the time of weigh-in.
6. Weights must not be more than 24 in. in front of tractor.
7. Drivers must remain seated while pulling or face disqualification.
8. Judges decisions are final.
9. Judges have the right to disqualify a tractor or driver for any rule violation.
10. Drawbar must be no more than 20 in. from the ground.
11. Drawbar must be a minimum of 18 in. from center of rear wheel to the point of hook-up.
12. Solid drawbar hook-up mandatory. No hook-ups to 3 point or quick hitch.
13. Shifting is allowed, but forward motion of the sled must not stop.
14. Hood, fuel tank, and fenders must remain in proper place for safety.
15. The first puller is the test puller. Before unhooking from the sled, the driver must decide whether to keep the pull or to re-pull in third or last position.
16. Each puller has a second chance to pull if he stops before the 50 ft. marker.
17. The pull will start with a tight hook-up. No jerk starts.
18. Driver is weighed with the tractor. Any alterations after you are officially weighed in will be cause for disqualification.
19. Weights must not interfere with hook-up to sled.
20. Driver is disqualified if anything falls from the tractor during pull.
21. Driver is disqualified if tractor goes out of boundaries.
22. Anyone caught tampering with tractors will be disqualified and ejected from the fair.
23. Driver will be disqualified for reckless driving.
24. No alcoholic beverages allowed. Any driver appearing intoxicated will not be allowed to pull.
25. No entry refunds for disqualifications.
26. No alcohol or water injection except for Special or Hot Farm class.
27. Only the driver and one helper in the pits per tractor.
28. Each puller must furnish his own clevis.
29. One start only in a pull-off.
30. Tractors with slipper clutches may run Special or Hot Farm Classes only.
Other Special Class Rules
 1. Max. 20.8.42 tires in Special class (Except 7500 – Max is 18.4.38)
 2. No cut tires.
 3. Max. 3000 RPMs.
 4. May jump up a weight but not down.
31. All tractors in Hot Farm & Special classes must have wide front ends.
32. All tractors in Hot Farm & Special classes- diesels must have air shut-offs and gas must have kill switches.
(All must be working)
33. All Hot Farm & Special classes must have wheelie skids extending 5 to 6 inches behind the rear wheels and approx. 13 inches above ground.
34. Special & Hot Farm Tractors are not allowed in Farm classes (except 8500, & 9500 Specials can run in 12500 & above Farm classes).
